CODE OF CONDUCT

Enjoy the game. Be positive to all around you. Be the person that others look forward to playing again.

All players, managers, coaches, committee members, parents and supporters of Normanhurst Eagles Football Club ('the Club') are to abide by the Club's Code of Conduct.

The Club has a duty of care to everyone associated with the Club. This includes match officials, opposing teams and the general community where the Club is represented.

All players, managers, coaches, committee members, parents and supporters associated with the Club must:

- Show respect to each other
- Show respect to opposing players, coaches and supporters
- Show respect to match officials
- Show respect to the local public, facilities and residents

Disrespectful behaviour can be shown in many forms. Examples include:

- Foul or abusive language
- Physical assault of any kind
- Threatening behaviour
- Degrading language or attitude towards others
- Discrimination on the basis of gender, colour or religion

This includes disrespectful behaviour to any other person that may be nearby or can overhear or observe such behaviour.

We especially ask that all associated with the Club respect officials and their calls. For example, thank officials for their efforts at the end of each game. Abuse of officials, in particular, will be severely dealt with by the relevant football associations.

If a breach of this Code is reported, the Club will investigate the incident and take action. This may include suspension or deregistration of a player, banning of a coach or referring the matter to other authorities.
